<u>Community Representatives of Malie, Faleula and Afega engage in the second Consultative Discussion for IOE Samoa Project.</u>

Malie, Apia, Samoa, 3rd **October 2024** – The Samoa Umbrella for Non-Governmental Organizations (SUNGO), in collaboration with Women in Business Development Incorporated (WIBDI), initiates the second of eight Consultative Discussion activities under the IOE Samoa Project. This project, launched in June, is funded by the European Union.

The local communities of Malie and the neighbouring villages of Afega and Faleula are participating in this consultative discussion to share knowledge and engage in dialogue with WIBDI family networks. Emphasis was placed on the inclusion of youth, equality, and people with disabilities. The discussion focuses on the impact of climate change, vulnerabilities, and strategies for engaging with the government on these issues.

SUNGO's Chief Executive Officer, addressed the participants, highlighting the significance of the initiative on Empowerment of Civil Society in Democratic Samoa (IOE Samoa Project) for the communities of Samoa.

SUNGO's Program Team Leader, Ms. Faapito Opetaia, led the discussions and provided critical information regarding climate change awareness, including definitions, its effects on communities, and ways to connect with current government initiatives.
